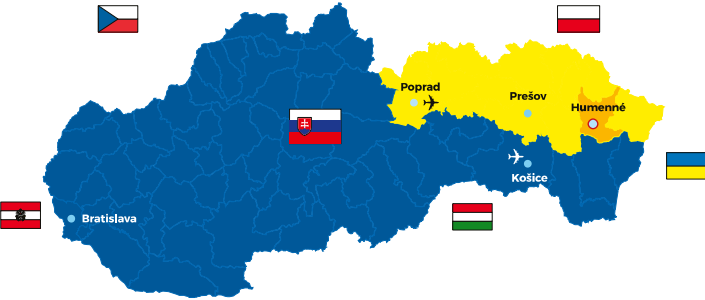

POSITION AND TRANSPORT

VICINITY OF EASTERN MARKETS
CONNECTIONS TO RAILWAY
AND AIR TRANSPORT
PLANNED CITY BYPASS

Humenné is located in Humenné district in the Prešov region, in the northeast of Slovakia. The location is convenient due to the proximity of other countries (Poland, Ukraine, and Hungary). The city is an important traffic junction toward Ukraine via Snina and Poland via Medzilaborce.

ROAD TRANSPORT

Humenné lies at an important road junction:

- 1st class road no. 74**
(Strážske – Humenné – Snina – Ubl’a – border with Ukraine)
- 2nd class road no. 558**
(Vranov nad Topľou – Humenné)
- 2nd class road no. 559**
(Humenné – Medzilaborce – Palota – border with Poland)
- 1st class road 79 A**
(Humenné – Trebišov – Slovenské Nové Mesto – border with Hungary)

CAR TRANSPORT

You can reach all the surrounding places by car in just 1 hour:

- to Snina (22 km)
- Medzilaborce (43 km)
- Michalovce (26 km)
- Vranov nad Topľou (23 km)
- Prešov (71 km)
- Košice (75 km)

The planned bypass for Humenné will improve the traffic situation and traffic safety.

D1 highway section passes near the city (Košice – Prešov – Poprad – Liptovský Mikuláš – Bratislava). D1 can be accessed in Košice or Prešov.

RAILWAY TRANSPORT

The city is connected to the railway network by the single-track route Michal’any – Strážske – Humenné – Medzilaborce. The Humenné – Snina – Stakčín route is of local importance, serving for the regular transport of the labor force from the whole region. The national concept of rail transport development for Humenné envisages the electrification of the main route Bánovce nad Ondavou – Strážske – Humenné.

Humenné is regularly connected with European metropolises via other transport companies with a focus on international bus transport (Vienna, Prague, Amsterdam, Geneva, Venice, Brussels)

AIR TRANSPORT

Humenné is connected to air transport through an airport of regional importance via Kamenica nad Čirochou, which is in the administration of the Ministry of the Interior of the SR. The airport has a fixed track of 1,300 meters with adequate equipment for irregular commercial operation using small aircraft.

The nearest airports with international operation is in Košice (75 km). Košice airport provides charter flights to seasonal destinations as well as several regular flights: Bratislava (Czech Airlines), Bristol (Wizz Air), Doncaster Sheffield (Wizz Air), Istanbul Atatürk (Turkish Airlines) since 16 June, Kiev (Czech Airlines), London Luton (Wizz Air), Prague (Czech Airlines), Warsaw (LOT Polish Airlines), Vienna (Austrian Airlines).

Other available international airports are in Krakow (PL), 282 km away, and in Budapest (HU) 332 km. From Kraków Airport im. Jana Pawła II and Budapest-Ferenc Liszt International Airport, there are regular flights to all European countries as well as to many overseas destinations.

The Humenné district has an area of 754.24 km² with over 62,000 inhabitants and an average density of 82,5 inhabitants per km². It brings together 62 municipalities. The seat of the district is the town of Humenné. Of the total population in the district, there is a slight prevalence of women (51,02 %; in absolute terms it is 31,740, according to the Statistical Office of the SR, as of 2Q 2019).

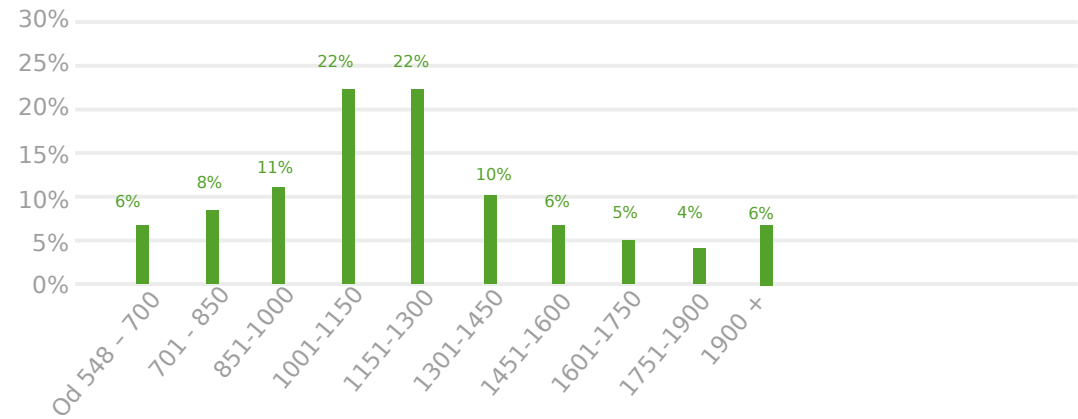
JOB VACANCIES

The average gross monthly salary of an employee
in the Prešov region for 2019 was 841 euros,
an increase of 4.8 % compared to 2018. However,
it is the lowest average salary among all regions
in Slovakia. In the Prešov region, six of nine
employees have a salary in the range of up to
EUR 800 gross (compared to two out of ten
employees in the Bratislava region).

LAND AND NON-RESIDENTIAL PREMISES

HUMENNÉ – GUTTMANOVO INDUSTRIAL PARK
Guttmanovo industrial park is well-prepared for the arrival of investors. The site was focused on the chemical, textile and food industries. The park has a unique location in terms of availability in the eastern markets. Free surfaces are instead usable for light industry without a burden on the environment or with a mild load, no heavy machinery. The owner of the free areas in the industrial park is the town of Humenné.

- Current free areas:
- free area no. 1 parcel no. 4939/45 with the acreage of 5,269 m² (0.527 ha)
 - free area no. 2 parcel no. 4939/37 with the acreage of 5,390 m² (0.539 ha)

They both have the infrastructure needed for the supply of electricity, gas, potable water, process water, and drainage connections for roof and waste water drainage. There is the option of connecting to central hot water, steam, compressed air and technical gas supply. In the park area, there is a communication system for truck and rail transport (a railway siding with loading ramp is situated next to free spaces in the park area).

There is an access road to both free areas. A permanent burden is established for the access road in favor of Tytex Slovakia, p.r., the owner is the city of Humenné.

- The rental price includes the following services:
- continuous operation of the gatehouse leading to the industrial park
 - cleaning and maintenance of roads inside the park
 - use of corporate railways and all associated equipment
 - park lighting
 - maintenance of green areas
 - functionality of all engineering/supply networks
 - fire protection inside the park

The land in the Humenné–Guttmanovo industrial park with an area of 8,534 m² was sold for a unit sales price of EUR 17.34/m².

INFRASTRUCTURE

WATER

UTILITY WATER for the needs of industrial enterprises is obtained from the surface take-off. On the Laborec River, there is a dam, from which water is pumped to the water treatment plant, the maximum allowable take-off is 165 l/s
THE WASTE WATER CLEANER for Humenné is located southwest of the city in the Laborec Valley and capacity-wise covers the city's needs for the future as well.

HEAT

Part of Humenné is supplied with heat for central heating (CH) and HSW (hot service water) from the central heat source Chemes a. s. Humenné with an installed boiler output of 344 MW and heat production of 3,414.96 TJ. Other heating facilities use boilers with natural gas combustion or electricity.

ELECTRICITY

Humenné is currently supplied with electricity from the 110/22 kV power station – Humenné.
SUPPLY of electric energy for individual customers of the city is secured by a network of transformer stations 22/0.4 kV.
DISTRIBUTION to individual transformers is performed by 22 kV external or 22 kV cable lines.

GAS

Connection to the gas source from the interstate gas pipeline – Bratstvo (IGP) and underground sources in the districts of Michalovce and Trebišov through the HP gas pipeline IGP – Strážske – Humenné DN 300, PN 4.0 MPa and Humenné – Snina DN 200, PN 4.0 MPa. Gas supply from HP gas pipeline through three HP/MP control stations: RS No. 1 – 3,000 m³/h, RS No. 2 – 5,000 m³/h, RS No. 3 – 16,000 m³/h (Chemes). A separate gas regulation station is built for the Guttmanovo industrial park.

ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SOURCES

Humenné partially uses renewable sources to produce electricity and heat in the form of solar collectors and photovoltaics, especially in family houses. At present, a biogas plant and two photovoltaic power plants are in operation. So far the only documented source of thermal water is the MLS – 1 well, which was carried out in 1975 in Podskalka, belonging to the cadastral area of Ptičie. The well was drilled at a depth of 908 – 928 m, with a collector temperature of 33 °C and total mineralization of 830 mg/l.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

The telephone network in the city and the district of Humenné is digitized, with excellent coverage of the mobile signal by mobile operators in the city, T-Com, T-Mobile, Orange, and O2 Slovakia. It is also possible to use alternative service providers. Humenné is included in the regional area 057 – Humenné, the whole territory of the city is covered by a signals for mobile communication devices in the NMT 450 MHz, GSM 900 MHz and GSM 1800 MHz networks. All urban areas are covered by the signal of mobile operators. Optical and Wi-Fi networks have been built by Orange, Slovak Telekom, and Antik. Internet connectivity is also provided by Slovanet, SATLAN, Minet, as well as the SANET data network for the provision of additional telecommunication and information services, especially for the academic sphere, i.e. the scientific, research, university and educational spheres.

The Office of Labor, Social Affairs and Family of Humenné pays contributions for the tools of active labor market policy. For example, in 2018, it paid a total of EUR 2,142,327.81 under the applied active labor market measures (ALMM). These tools have been affected by several factors. The most important of these include the closure of the 2007–2014 programming period and the completion of funding under the Operational Program Employment and Social Inclusion, as well as the amendment of Act No. 5/2004 on employment services with effect from 1/1/2015.

OVERVIEW OF SELECTED CONTRIBUTIONS FOR EMPLOYEES:

Employment allowance for a disadvantaged jobseeker – §50:

The average agreed duration of job support (contribution payout time) is 14.6 months. Dozens of jobs will be created annually thanks to the contribution.

Contribution to support the creation of a job in the first

regularly paid employment – §51a: This instrument of active labor market policy was introduced to legislation on 1/1/2015 as an amendment to the Employment Services Act. The tool is designed to support young people under the age of 29, who have not gained their first regular paid employment with an employer i.e. which would last at least 6 months after completing their continuing vocational training.

Contribution to Graduate Practice – §51:

This contribution is intended for graduates as well as employers. Employers' demand is several times higher than the offer of graduates who have met the conditions for graduate practice. For example, in 2018, the Office supported graduate practice for 56 new graduates from the UoZ ranks.

PROJECTS TO SUPPORT EMPLOYMENT

The Office of Labor, Social Affairs and Family of Humenné organizes and coordinates activities aimed at choosing primary and secondary schools for hundreds of pupils and dozens of teachers. It organizes group meeting right in schools, excursions to manufacturing companies (e.g. OLDRA TI Slovakia, ANDRITZ Slovakia and TYTEX) as well as information and consultation meetings.

Within the RE-PAS project implemented pursuant to Section 54, Par. 1, letter d) of Act No. 5/2004 on employment services, the Labor Office provides hundreds of contributions annually for the requalification of jobseekers. The greatest interest is in nursing courses, welding courses, SBS courses, and German language courses for caregivers. The Office implemented, for example, the training programs “Nursing Care in the SR/2” and “Logistics and Stock Management”.

As part of the National Employment Promotion Project, the Labor Office also organized the project “Through Practical Experience to Employment”. The aim of the project is to acquire, enhance and deepen the professional skills, knowledge and practical experience of young people below the age of 29, corresponding in particular to their attained level of education in the relevant group of educational or study disciplines. This is done in the form of mentored incorporation and practice with an employer who creates a job for the purpose of being placed and remains in the labor market.

The district of Humenné is second in the Prešov region regarding creation of the gross domestic product. The local economy consists mainly of engineering, construction, food industries and services. According to the branch structure, most entrepreneurs in the city and district of Humenné do business in the corporate industry (33 %) and industrial production (15 %). In other sectors it is 13 % of them, in construction 11 %, agriculture, forestry and fishing 9 %, health and social assistance 8 %, and vocational, scientific and technical activities 6 %. We have observed an increase in the number of economically active entities in Humenné and its surroundings. Foreign economic development is also important for the enterprises in the city, as most local production companies are export-oriented.

The city’s economy is stable, with significant cash surpluses in recent years – the balance in 2015 was EUR 1,316,976, in 2016 EUR 2,613,663, 2017 ending with a balance of EUR 1,638,941 and 2018 with a cash balance of EUR 1,902,949. Humenné complies with budget management rules and debt indicators are well below the national average.

FINANCIAL INDICATORS OF THE CITY

The financial indicators show whether the government has managed with a surplus or deficit in terms of the current and capital account as a whole. They explain how the local government can cover its current expenditure (the running of the self-government) and capital expenditure (asset redeployment) from its current income (e.g. tax revenue) and capital income (e.g. sale of property). They also assess to what extent funds are available in the financial accounts of municipalities, in a sufficient amount to repay short-term liabilities – what is the immediate liquidity of the municipality.



All planned investments and development activities will be provided by the city without increasing local taxes and fees, which remain the lowest in the region. Even in public tenders, the city makes transparency provisions that offer savings. Thanks to this, City Hall can manage a high cash surplus, which will be used in full to invest and improve the city’s property. Humenné has low tax rates compared to other cities. Their amount has not changed since 2013, which in the case of apartment tax means EUR 0.15 per m and the municipal solid waste tax is EUR 13.50/person/year.

The city is actively involved in the process of obtaining non-repayable funds from various grant schemes. These resources are planned for use in the carrying out of more widespread investments.

Since 2016, the city has been applying for non-repayable financial contributions and subsidies on the basis of new challenges under the new Economic and Social Development Program of Humenné for the years 2016–2022, with a view to 2025.

IMPORTANT PROJECTS IN THE CITY

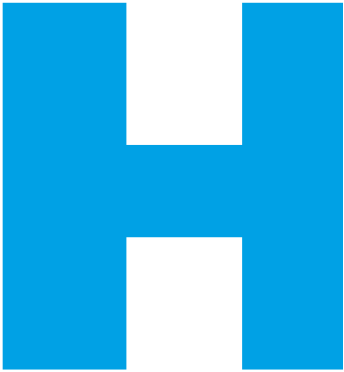
Humenné does its best to make use of the financial funds provided by the European Union. This is evidenced by the renewed city center, renovated squares, repaired buildings, planted greenery, and modernized infrastructure.

Thanks to these funds, the city was able to renovate most primary schools in its territory, reconstruct the City Hall, renovate public lighting, and make many other investments. The aim is to promote lifelong learning as well as the social sphere. Great emphasis is placed on the environment for the citizens of the region, where investments were made in the form of a separation yard, the purchase of municipal cleaning technology and the closure of an old municipal solid waste landfill.

Humenné offers great potential for the further development of economic activities with the possibility of obtaining public support for their implementation. We believe the business environment of our city will fit investment plans and help in the development of entrepreneurial activity, thereby enhancing the economic development of the whole region. Its progress is also largely influenced by the absorption of the EU and subsidies from the state budget, funds that have so far been implemented in the following projects:

Humenné offers excellent conditions for acquiring knowledge and skills. Education and training is one of the most important and lasting priorities of the city. Within its competence, the local government creates favorable conditions in all educational spheres.

In the school year 2016/2017 there are 15 kindergartens (10 in the founding capacity of the city, 3 private schools, 1 elementary school with kindergarten and 1 Christian kindergarten), 8 elementary schools in the town’s founding capacity (1 elementary art school, 2 private art schools, 2 special elementary schools) and 10 secondary schools.

In the city, you can visit a museum with historical exhibition in a Renaissance manor house and an open-air museum in a nearby park, which is a national cultural monument. It is also worthwhile to see the city gallery and visit the library or the observatory. There are many associations in the city developing cultural, social and popular education activities.

Every year, more than 20 regular cultural events and music festivals, as well as many concerts and events take place in Humenné, not only in the far-flung house of culture but also in the city center on the stage by the famous Fountain of Love.

RENAISSANCE MANOR HOUSE

The manor house in Humenné is a national cultural monument and the seat of Vihorlat Museum. The building was and still remains the dominant feature of the city. It's one of the largest and most spacious mansion style buildings in Slovakia. In the past, the mansion was the seat of the Drugetov dynasty, later belonging to the noble Andrassy family (1812). The manor house is adjacent to the Park of Peace. The Renaissance manor house was renovated several times, most recently in 2016.

MONUMENTS

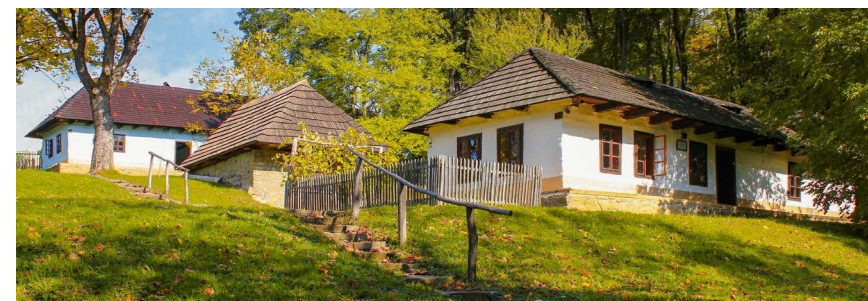
The town of Humenné offers many cultural monuments for history enthusiasts. The most prominent feature of the city is the Renaissance manor house with the marvelous adjacent Park of Peace, in which visitors can find a number of precious trees besides an oasis of peace and relaxation. Other important cultural monuments in the city are also very popular in addition to the interesting folk architecture exhibition, such as Calvary with the Church of Our Lady of Sorrows from 1891, the Fountain of Love as the dominant structure of the city, nearby statue of St. John of Nepomuk created in the 1920's, and the statue of the good soldier Švejk, whose creator is Humenné native Jaroslav Drotár. Visitors of the city can also see the Jewish Cemetery, which covers 1.7 hectares and is one of the largest Jewish cemeteries in Slovakia, as well as the World War I and II cemeteries, part of the city cemetery.



ROMAN-CATHOLIC CHURCH OF ALL SAINTS

The Church of All Saints is a national cultural monument. It is the the most eastern Gothic sacral building in Europe apart from the brick Gothic. With the monastery, it creates a unified whole. It was originally consecrated to Our Lady. Part of the church's decoration are the stained-glass windows by the academically trained painter Mikuláš Klimčák, native of Humenné. This Franciscan church was built in the 15th century to honor the martyr St. Boniface. Relics of the deceased are kept in the side chapel of St. John of Nepomuk in a glass showcase. At present, the parish church is dedicated to All Saints.

SKANZEN

The open-air museum is an exhibition of folk architecture and housing. The area of the exhibition is located almost in the center of Humenné, in a terrain that reflects the character of Upper Zemplín. There are structures in it that characterize folk architecture and life in the East Carpathian region in the past. The oldest open-air museum is the Greek-Catholic wooden church of St. Michael the Archangel. The open-air museum also offers a view of agricultural machines, a water mill, a forge workshop, demonstrations of folk handicrafts and other attractions.

TOURISM AND NATURE

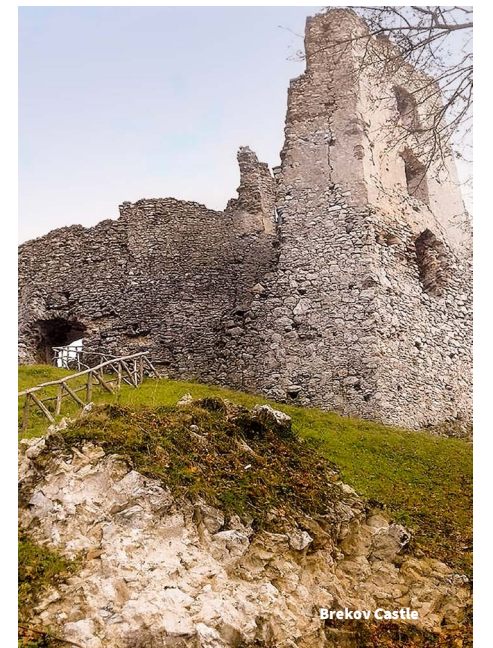
Humenné is located in an astonishing valley surrounded by beautiful forests on either side. The region around Humenné offers many opportunities for summer and winter tourism, cycling, as well as opportunities for shorter and longer walks around. The highest altitudes include Sokol (405 MASL), Petočová (378 MASL) and Barančov (364 MASL). The most popular places for hiking in the region include RO Hubková and the nearby peak in NR Humenský Sokol.

Other areas suitable for tourism located near Humenné are:

- Medieval castles: Jasenov, Brekov, Čičva, Vinné
- The ponds in Brestová and Volová

JASENOV CASTLE (CASTLE RUINS)

The castle was probably built by the Rackajov family in the 13th century after the invasion of the Tatars. Later, the Drugethov family became its owner and it belonged to them until the 17th century. In 1644, Juraj Rákoczi's army occupied the castle. It was badly damaged in the siege and never repaired. In the 18th century, it was owned by the Csáky family and in the 19th century by the Andrassy family. Efforts to rescue the castle were evident at the beginning of the 20th century by the then monumental authorities. In front of the castle, there is a fireplace overlooking Humenné, and there are also several smaller fireplaces inside the castle palace.

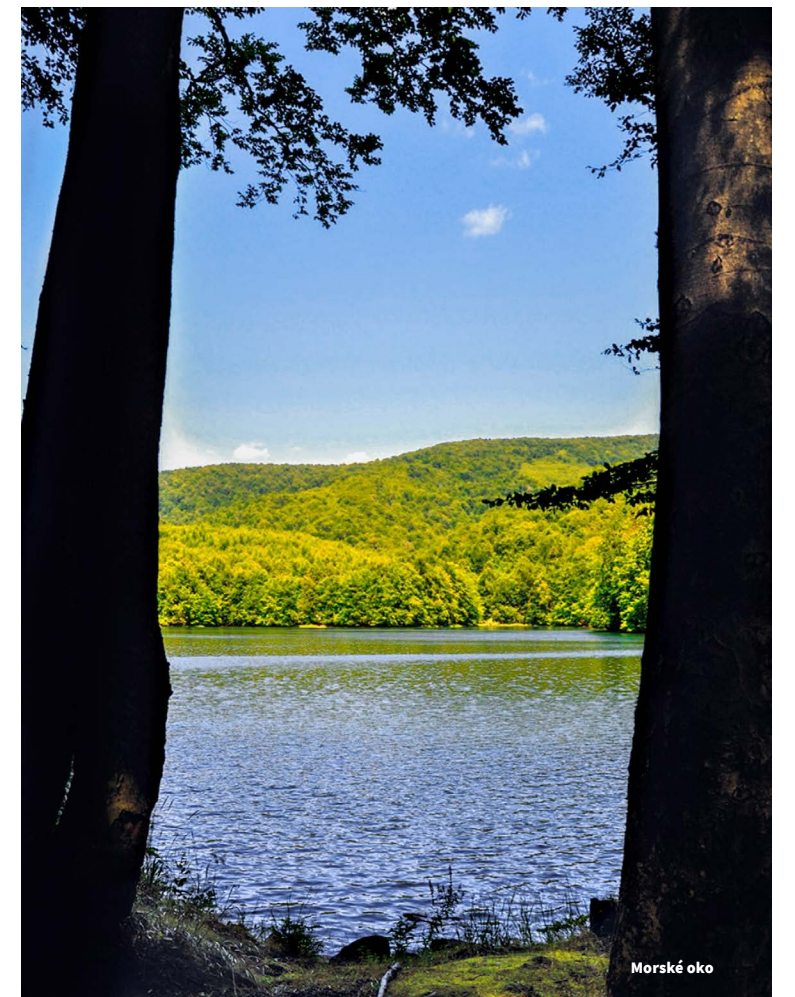
MORSKÉ OKO

Morské oko in the protected landscape area of the Eastern Carpathians lies at an altitude of 618 m above sea level and is a state nature reserve with protected flora and fauna. It is the largest volcanic lake in Slovakia with an area of 13 ha. One of the dominant sights of the Vihorlat Hills, Sninský kameň, rises above it, known for its beautiful view of the surrounding hills and valley.
